

15 QUESTIONS To Ask Your Child After School



To get the conversation going and make connection, try asking these questions to your child after school:

1. What was the best thing that happened at school today?
2. Tell me what was the worst thing that happened at school today?
3. What was the hardest thing you had to do today?
4. Tell me something that made you laugh today?
5. Tell me about what you read in class today. What did your teacher read to you today?
6. What was your favourite part of the day at school?
7. What are you looking forward to at school tomorrow?
8. Did you get frustrated with anything at school today?
9. What subject do you like the best? Why?
10. Did anyone do something nice for you today?
11. Did you do something nice for someone? Did anything big or unusual happen at school today?
12. Are you a good friend? Why do you think so?
13. What did you do at recess?
14. What did you learn that was new that you didn't already know?
15. For older kids: Do you feel prepared for your history test? Or is there anything on your mind that you'd like to talk about?
